# From the President

We made it through our 4<sup>th</sup> of July Fireworks Stand sales week! It was a lot of work and took a lot of planning, but those of you who participated and supported us really made a difference. And for that I am very grateful to you all.

A lot of members may not realize that we exist from our membership dues and rental fees to pay our annual expenses. We are a 501(c)4 non-profit and get our funds through dues and private sources, instead of from grants and foundations that 501(c)3 non-profits do.

The Fireworks Stand has been subsidizing the clubhouse for many years, and yet hardly any members volunteered to work shifts or to help with any of our other fundraisers we hold throughout the year.

The Board of Directors is trying to do what is best for the long run of this Association. We want the LGCA to be financially strong and have enough member participation to keep it going for many years to come.

In order to accomplish this & meet our financial responsibilities, we are exploring the possibility of increasing dues and clubhouse rental rates, with tiered discounts given for members contributing volunteer service hours per year. Several other schools & organizations have successfully used this method to get volunteers for their fundraising events and we hope that this will work for our Association as well.

Nothing has been decided yet, but I wanted to let you all know that it is being considered. I hope you all understand that our intentions are for the good of the whole Association and not for short-term gains.

### Tip of the Month

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, the top two months for vehicle thefts are July and August and 40-50% of vehicle theft is due to driver error. To prevent being the victim of this crime:
