

## **Household Hazardous Waste drop-off in Lakewood**

The EDCO Recycling & Transfer Station is open every 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday of the month for Lakewood residents to drop off their household waste, sharps, and e-waste. EDCO is located at 2755 California Ave in Signal Hill and is open from 9am to 2pm. (rain or shine)

If you need to schedule a bulky item pickup, you are entitled to six pickups per year at your home. To schedule a pickup, call EDCO at 562-531-3054 by 3:30pm *the day before* your normal trash pickup. (Bulky items include: used furniture, appliances, mattresses, e-waste, and broken-down boxes tied in twine, but building materials are **NOT** included.)
