
NOT COOL DUDE!

Swimming during COVID-19

Swim healthy. Stay healthy.

You <u>MUST</u> have a <u>Waiver of Liability for Pool Use</u> on file <u>PRIOR</u> to using the pool. Refer to COVID-19 Los Angeles County and City of Lakewood Social Distancing Rules.

- No more than 10 people can be present in the pool at a time.
- If you see 10 people upon your arrival, then depart and return later.
- Bring hand sanitizer with you and wipe frequently touched surfaces in the pool and restroom area.
- Do not share anything that you brought with you (towels, toys, etc.)
- Follow 6-feet distancing rules with people outside your household.
- No guests from outside the Gardens are allowed at this time.
- Masks must be worn in the clubhouse and pool deck area.
- Take all your items with you upon your departure.

NOTE: Failure to follow these rules could result in suspension of the clubhouse/pool use and/or membership.


