Just wanted to reach out to you this week and remind you that Sunday, March 13th, Daylight Saving Time Begins.

Don't forget to Spring Forward an hour on Saturday night or Sunday morning. You can also use the time change to remind you to perform some basic home maintenance tasks. Such as:

- Smoke & Carbon Monoxide Detectors: Test batteries and replace.
- Toilet: Check for leaks.
- Dryer: Vacuum lint from ducts and surrounding areas.
- Washer: Clean water inlet filters; check hoses and replace them if they are leaking.
- Wiring: Check for frayed cords and wires; repair or replace them as needed.
- Range/Stove Hood: Wash fan blades and housing.

A little regular maintenance can save thousands down the road when you decide to list your home.


