

Celebrate July 4th Safely

Independence Day is just around the corner, so here's a reminder for you and your neighbors: don't use illegal fireworks and don't tolerate those who do. These are the rules we want residents and their guests to live by as we celebrate the Fourth of July. The only fireworks that are legal in Lakewood are those that are rated "Safe and Sane." Safe and Sane fireworks can be purchased from any authorized firework stand including those in Lakewood. Be sure to look for the fireworks sale permit and State of California Fire Marshal's seal that all stands are required to display. Fireworks bought in other states, over the internet, or from any other source are illegal. Legal fireworks may only be discharged on July 4th between 10 a.m. and 11 p.m.





Lakewood will continue to target violators this year by deploying extra deputies on July 4. Our "zero tolerance" policy means everyone they catch violating the law will be cited. Most violations carry a fine of \$1,000. As a reminder, homeowners or tenants can and will be held responsible for what occurs on their property.

We rely on our community to identify violators. If you know of a person/residence with a history of unruly/unsafe celebrations that are not in compliance with the law, please report it by calling the July 4th Tip Hotline at 562-866-9771, extension SAFE (7233). Please provide as much information as possible about the person, location and violation. You can also report by visiting www.lakewoodcity.org/safe4th. Your information can remain confidential and the sooner you report this information, the better!
