Tip of the Month

When doing your holiday shopping, it is safer to use a credit card instead of a debit card wherever possible. If you must use a debit card, however, you should never hand it to anyone. Keep it in your possession at all times. When using the keypad to enter your pin on a debit card machine, <u>always</u> press your open hand against the keypad for 3-5 seconds once you're done to erase any thermal imprint left by your fingers while entering your four-digit pin. Thermal imaging devices can capture the heat remaining on the pushed keys.

Lakewood City Service Changes for December/New Year

Lakewood City Hall will be closed the week of December 26-30 and on Monday, January 2. Trash pickup will continue as usual.

Special street sweeping and parking rules will be in effect.

DASH Transit service will not be available December 26 and January 2.

For trash pick-up and sweeping, the following schedule applies for the holiday season:

- Trash pick-up will occur on its normal schedule every day during the holiday weeks of December 26-30 and January 2-6.
- Street sweeping will not occur in residential areas the week of December 26-30 and on Monday, January 2. There will be no makeup sweeps for those days. There will be no residential street sweepingrelated parking enforcement the week of December 26-30 or on January 2.
- Street sweeping services and parking enforcement will return to normal on Tuesday, January 3, 2017.

Christmas Tree Recycling: For two weeks after Christmas (from Dec 26 through Jan 6, 2017), EDCO will pick up discarded Christmas trees on Thursdays. Flocked trees are OK, but decorations, tinsel, and metal or plastic stands must be removed. Wooden tree stands can be left on the tree. The tree must not be in a bag. Trees over 6 feet tall must be cut in half .. Thank you to everyone that purchased a Christmas Tree from LGCA's fund raising event!

Post Holiday Extra Trash Service: For the week immediately following Christmas (Dec 26-30)EDCO will run an extra truck each Thursday to help with extra added holiday refuse. You can leave up to 10 standard size trash bags about 2 feet from your trash can for pick-up. Holiday and appliance boxes may be left there as well.
