BUNCO NIGHT IS COMING!!

Bunco Night will begin at the LGCA Clubhouse on May 18, 2017 starting at 6:30pm. Buy-in is \$10 and the winning pot will be split 50/50 between the winner and the LGCA. Bunco will be ongoing every 3rd Thursday of the month.

What is Bunco? Bunco is a social dice game, traditionally played with 12 players who are divided into three tables with 4 players at each table. But really, any number can play.

There are six rounds, progressing in order from one to six, where the number of the round serves as the target for that round's rolls. Within a round, players alternate turns rolling three dice, are aiming to obtain the target number. Players gain one point for each die matching the target. If the player gets three-of-a-kind of the target number (a Bunco), they get 21 points. The round stops when a player at a head table obtains 21 points.

Whoever wins the most rounds is the overall winner. Come and join in the fun!

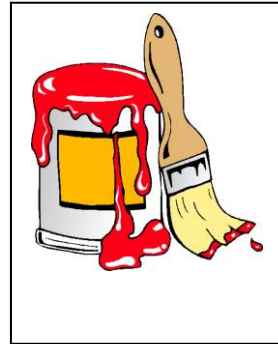

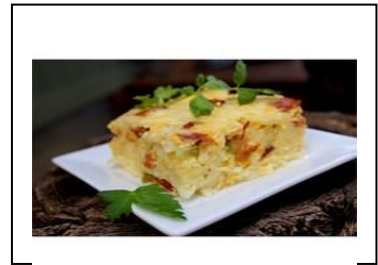

Easter Brunch Recipe: Breakfast Casserole

Ingredients

- 1 pound bacon
- 1/4 cup diced onion
- 1/4 cup diced green bell pepper
- 3 cups shredded Cheddar cheese
- 8 eggs
- 2 cups milk
- 1 (16 ounce) package frozen hash brown potatoes, thawed

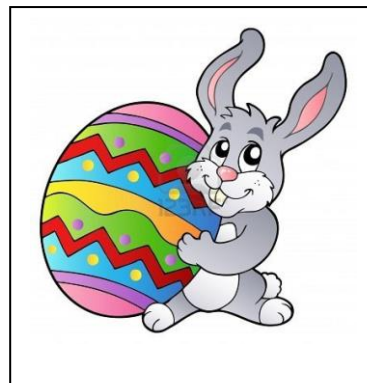


Directions

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Lightly grease a 7x11 inch casserole dish.
2. Fry the bacon in a large, deep skillet over medium-high heat until evenly browned, about 10 minutes. Drain on a paper towel-lined plate. Crumble.
3. In a large bowl beat together eggs and milk. Mix in cheese, bacon, onion and green pepper. Stir in the thawed hash browns. Pour mixture into prepared casserole.
4. Cover with aluminum foil and bake in preheated oven for 45 minutes. Uncover and bake for another 30 minutes until eggs have set.
